



Formed in 2011, Midnite Hellion is a three-piece Heavy Metal band from Trenton, NJ USA, infusing Traditional Heavy Metal with Speed Metal. Midnite Hellion has shared the stage with numerous bands, including Yngwie J. Malmsteen, OverKill, Dirkschneider, Artillery, Flotsam and Jetsam, Grim Reaper, Whiplash, RIOT, Onslaught, and many more.

Having held a stronghold in the Tri-State Area since their beginning, Midnite Hellion has also toured the Midwest and Mountain regions of the US supporting OTEP in December 2018, as well as a one-off performance in Chicago at the Ragnarökr Metal Apocalypse festival in 2014. Midnite Hellion is known for their high-energy concerts that are aggressive with a dose of humor.

Midnite Hellion released their first full-length album, "Condemned To Hell," on Witches Brew Records on September 15th, 2017, and their record release concert was held two days later at the Starland Ballroom in Sayreville, NJ in support of Exodus and Obituary. The band is currently in preparation for more domestic and their first international appearances.
