

TECHNICAL RIDER

General Information

Midnite Hellion is a 3-piece, Heavy Metal band from Trenton, New Jersey. Although there is some flexibility in many areas, please understand that many of these needs are critical to the performance and safety of everyone involved in the event, and are simply not a "wish list." If you are unable to provide the required equipment, please contact Drew Rizzo at (609) 306-7549 or drew@midnitehellion.com immediately to discuss the necessary details for hosting a performance at your venue.

PA Sound System

Midnite Hellion requires an adequate PA system provided for the concert room with sufficient power to supply a clean and undistorted one hundred-ten (110) dB SPL RMS to the mixing desk. The PA system needs to be setup in a stereo (left and right) configuration.

Staging

The stage area should be at least twenty feet (20') by thirty feet (30') to allow for plenty of room for the three (3) members of Midnite Hellion to perform. The band's equipment cannot be properly set up on the ground (blacktop, grass, dirt, concrete, etc.). The stage should be sturdy enough to sustain the weight of the equipment and members without any noticeable instability that would adversely affect the performance of the band. If the event is to be held outdoors, the stage area must be covered to protect the musicians and equipment from prolonged exposure to the elements. See attached stage plot.

Power Requirements

Midnite Hellion requires to have three (3) dedicated twenty (20) Amp circuits. Circuits must be capable of providing an uninterrupted one hundred-twenty to one hundred-twenty-five (120-125) VAC. We require to have a minimum of three (3) outlets per dedicated circuit, equally spaced throughout the stage/concert room. All outlets must be three (3)- prong and earth-grounded for safety.

Arrival, Load-in, Sound Check

Please provide detailed directions at least two weeks before the date of the performance with the complete address of the venue and telephone contact. A safe parking location for our trailer and tow vehicle is required to be at least fifty feet (50') long by ten feet (10') wide. Load-in should be located near a door that is located close to the stage. There should also be a ramp, or lift of some sort to get our gear inside the venue. If the stage is not large enough to accommodate our equipment to be backlined on stage during the opening performances, there should be a safe and secure area to store our gear prior to our performance. If possible, it would be greatly appreciated to have one or two local loaders to assist in the changeover to expedite the process. Please coordinate with Drew Rizzo at (609) 306-7549 or drew@midnitehellion.com regarding arrival, sound check, doors-open and on-stage times. The promoter or event coordinator should be at the venue at the crew's arrival time.

Green Room

A room for the band to get changed and get some rest before and after the performance would be appreciated. Mirrors, sinks, seating, and electrical outlets are preferred. A case of bottled water for the band would be greatly appreciated also, as well as six (6) clean white hand towels for the stage.

Merchandise

A designated area of the venue will be needed for the band's merchandise display. A high traffic area of venue (i.e. lobby, by the door inside the performance area, etc) is preferred. A well-lit area of twelve feet (12') wide by ten feet (10') deep by ten feet (10') high is required to properly set up our merchandise area. If possible, a wire wall grid would be greatly appreciated to hang our merchandise, as well as two folding tables six feet (6') wide by three feet (3') deep each and four comfortable chairs. If there is a dedicated venue merchandise person on-hand to run the table during our performance, it would be greatly appreciated. With the exception of 30 minutes before, during, and 20 minutes after our performance, we will be present at our merchandise area.
